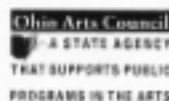


Watercolor Ohio 2005

Alex Powers has been a painter and self-employed art teacher since 1970. A Myrtle Beach, South Carolina resident, He exhibits in galleries in six states, and among his many national juried exhibition awards is the Gold Medal at the 1997 American Watercolor Society Annual Exhibition. He travels and teaches 8 or 10 workshops per year. Alex has juried dozens of national exhibitions. He is the author of *Painting people in Watercolor, A Design Approach*, which is a Watson-Guption publication.



Alex's painting style has evolved into a personal content-dominated imagery. Using gouache, charcoal, pastel and sometimes collage on illustration board, his loose realism combines an emphasis on drawing with an awareness of the art of our times. "I attempt to deal with issues such as human origins, religion, philosophy, economic inequality, etc. These overwhelming issues are difficult to deal with, but they are what interest me. And, since I believe in the singularity of life and art, these issues are the content of my current work."

Workshop Description:

DESIGN AND PERSONAL STYLE WITH MODELS

This dynamic workshop will focus on participants' personal painting style and design. Alex will help you identify what you want to express in your work through choices in design dominance, art materials, subject matter, and techniques.

Models will be provided for this workshop. The class *will not* be structured as a figure drawing/anatomy class. The models are provided as subject matter to make personal statements within your paintings. If you don't usually work with models at home, you are encouraged to bring your own source material from which to work. You will not miss anything if you choose not to use the models.

The workshop will include: slide lectures, individual critiques of work from home, individual critiques of work at your table, group critiques, models, a demonstration painting, hand-outs and examples of Alex's paintings.

Come to this exciting workshop with the intention of identifying more clearly what your work is about, and how to express it in a more personal way.
